Distinguished-Flying Cross, per par. 2, General Orders #75, Hq 14th Air Force, dated 8 October 1944.

Air Medal (Oak-Leaf Cluster), per par. 7, General Orders #3, Hq 14th Air Force, dated 8 January 1945.

Penning is also authorized to wear two (2) Battle Participation Stars to the Asiatic-Pacific Theater Ribbon for campaigns in India-Burma from 28 March 1944 to 5 June 1944 per General Order #53, Hq 14th Air Force, dated 17 May 1945 and for campaign in China from 12 June 1944 to 28 October 1944 per General Order #31, Hq 14th Air Force, dated 2 April 1945.
